60 years after the NHS was set up its very future is under threat.

UnitedHealth, one of the biggest multi-billion dollar private health companies in the US, have been prosecuted there for defrauding patients!

They have just taken over three GP's surgeries in Camden and have been employed by Westminster PCT to draw up plans for a polyclinic. With Virgin Healthcare and other private companies, they hope to cash in on the huge profits to be made from this government's plans to put local GP services out to tender round the country.

In Camden, two polyclinics planned at UCH and Royal Free hospitals threaten the closure of local GP surgeries and may be privatised. We have managed to postpone private tendering of our Out of Hours doctors' services, but they are also still at threat.

Over a million people have signed a petition against polyclinics. Campaigns are beginning to force local Primary Care Trusts to back off. It is time to make a stand for our NHS.
