Keep our NHS public

- Up to 50 per cent of Accident & Emergency services threatened with closure across the UK
- Up to 60 NHS departments and 30 smaller community hospitals up for closure.
- £259 million cuts in health spending in London last year
- A further £70 million cuts were announced in London last month
- Hundreds of jobs to go in Hammersmith, the Royal Free, St Georges and other hospitals in Greater London.
- Queen Elizabeth Hospital, in Woolwich, is bankrupt because of PFI
- GP services and diagnostic tests are up for privatisation
